

This is what Byggnads wants in the Byggavtalet

- A wage increase of 4.2% and an increase in the extra pension contribution.
- Greater influence over work time scheduling and better inspections against labor crime.
- Extra money to reduce wage loss when you take parental leave for child care (vab).
- Compensation for travel time to and from work in addition to mileage allowance.
- Guaranteed weekend pay (helglön) when you work on a holiday.
- Better working environment and fair wages for machine and crane operators.
- Strengthen the safety representative's influence in project planning for a safer work environment.
- Clearer requirements for what should be included in your health check-up.

This is what Byggföretagen want

- 12-month probationary period for apprentices.
- Introduce individual wages to arbitrarily set salaries.
- Remove travel compensation if you live less than 10 km from the workplace.
- Make it impossible for crane and machine operators to participate in piece rates.
- Remove daily cleaning of staff areas.
- Make it easier to hire on a temporary basis, which reduces job security.
- Have the ability to order night work even if the union (Byggnads) says no.
- Force local agreements that are worse than the collective agreement.
